



Mark 6:45-52, Matthew 14:22-33

Part 1 - The circumstances leading up to our story (Mark 6:1-44)

- Discipleship Lesson 1 - If Jesus needed alone time with God, so do you.

Part 2 - The call (Mark 6:50, Matthew 14:28-29)

- Discipleship Lesson 2 - It is the presence of Christ, not the altering of our circumstances that gives the disciple courage
- Discipleship Lesson 3 - A disciple is familiar with the voice of Jesus
- Discipleship Lesson 4 - A disciple calls out to God to call them toward His will.
- Discipleship Lesson 5 - Through faithful following in the every day, a disciple is prepared to follow Jesus in dramatic ways

Part 3 - Sinking and Rising Faith (Matthew 14:30-33)
