Deliverance - Commission - Covenant

Exodus 1-19 tells the story of Israel's deliverance from Egypt and God's commissioning of His people. Exodus 20 marks the beginning of the Covenant God creates for Israel. The Covenant explanation will not conclude until Leviticus 27.

Exodus 23:20-33

God's provision for His people

<u>The Angel of God</u>

God is going to guard and guide Israel into the Promised Land.

The People of God

God had called Israel to be His covenant people. They were to listen to God's directives, obey them fully, and worship Him only.

The Promised Land

God was going to provide a "space" for His people to live and prosper. He would drive out the enemies and be the security His people needed.

<u>Exodus 24:1-18</u>

The Covenant Ratified

God's People Embrace Their Calling

The People of God agreed to live by the Covenant revealed to them by God Himself. They committed themselves to obedience.

The Sprinkling of Blood

As a part of the ceremonial sealing of the Covenant, God's people were "covered" in blood.

The Covenant Meal in God's Presence

On behalf of the people, Moses and the leaders were drawn into the presence of God, and they shared a covenant meal together.

Worship and Law

Moses was drawn further up the mountain to spend a season in God's presence. God would reveal to Him the Law and the plans for the Tabernacle.
