Finally - The Tabernacle!

The Tabernacle was constructed about 1 year from the actual exodus from Egypt. Moses was in charge of the set up. The materials were all meticulously prepared by the skilled people. The furniture was anointed and set apart as holy. The priests were anointed and set apart. The structure was in place on the first day of the first month of the second year of the Exodus, and God's people were prepared for the Celebration of the Unleavened Bread.
